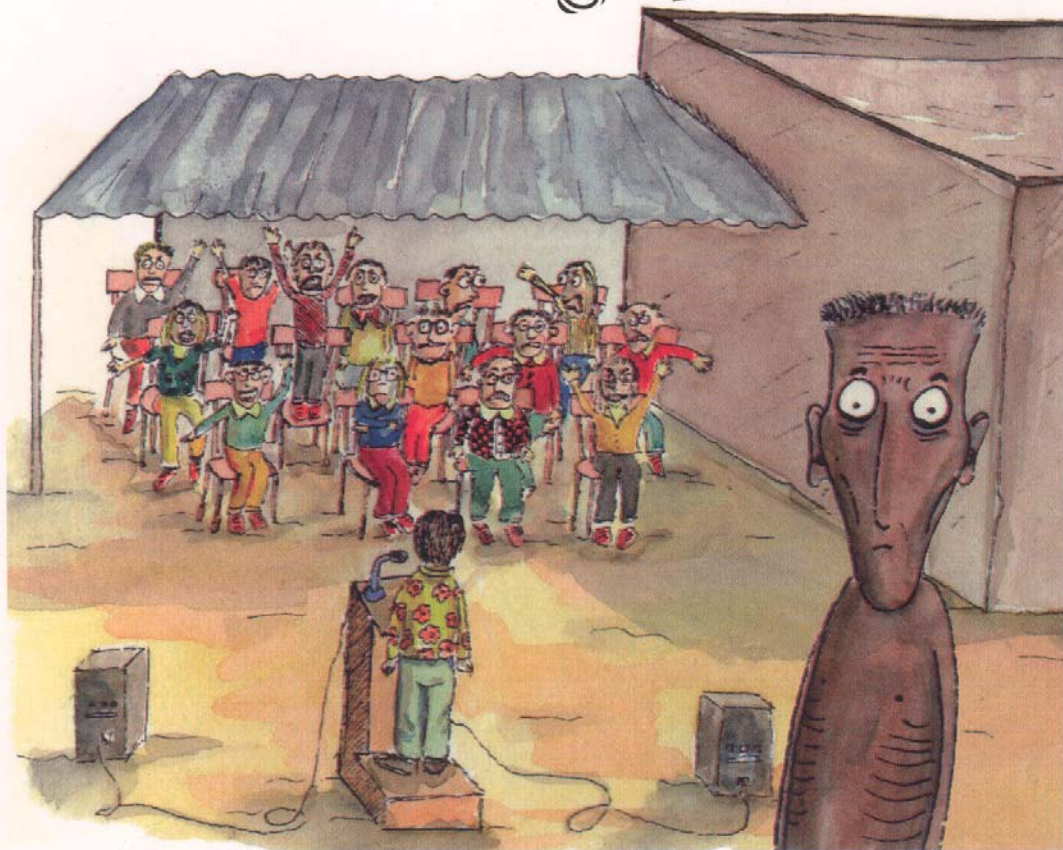


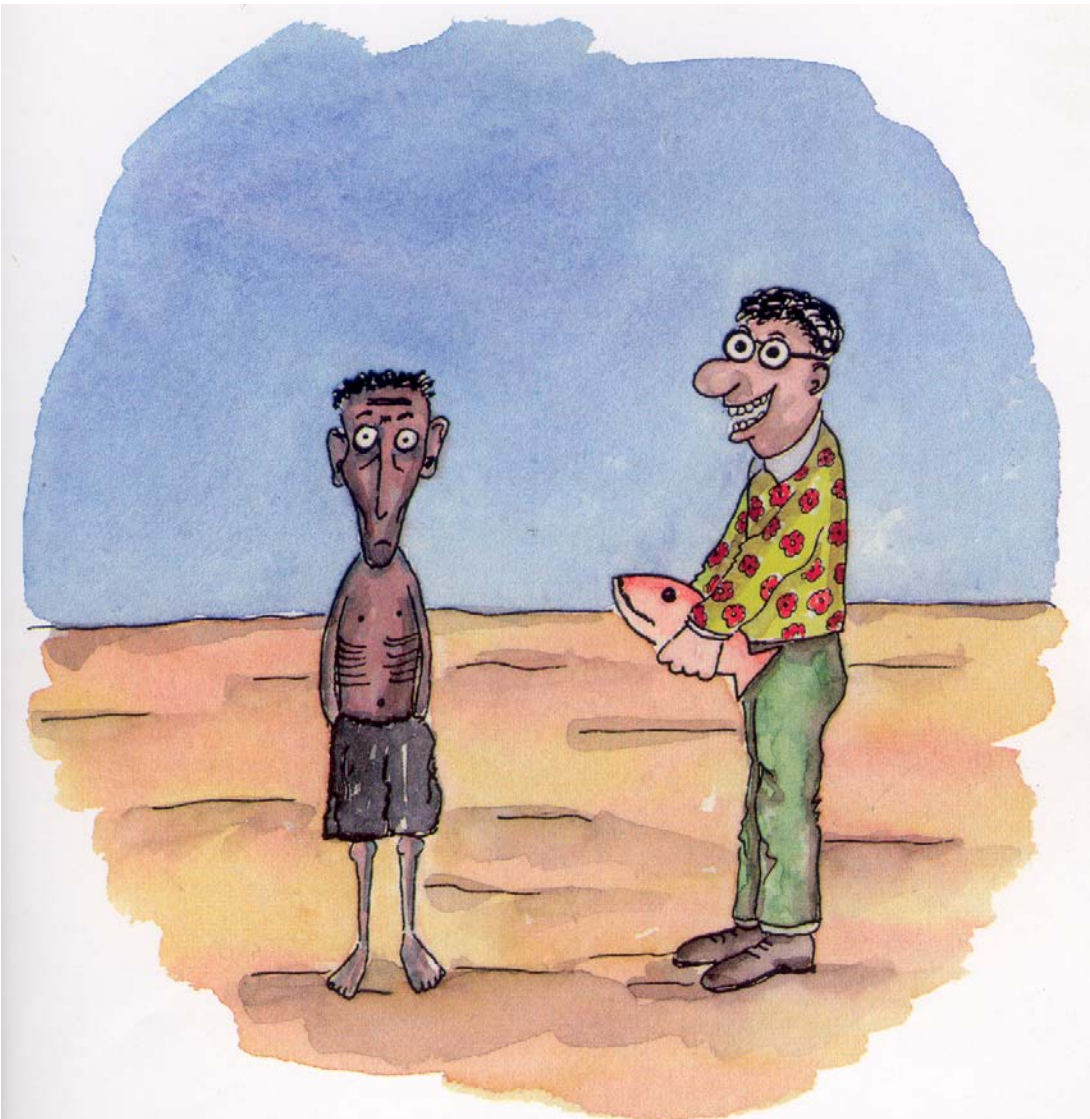
The Hungry Man

If a man is hungry don't give him a fish.

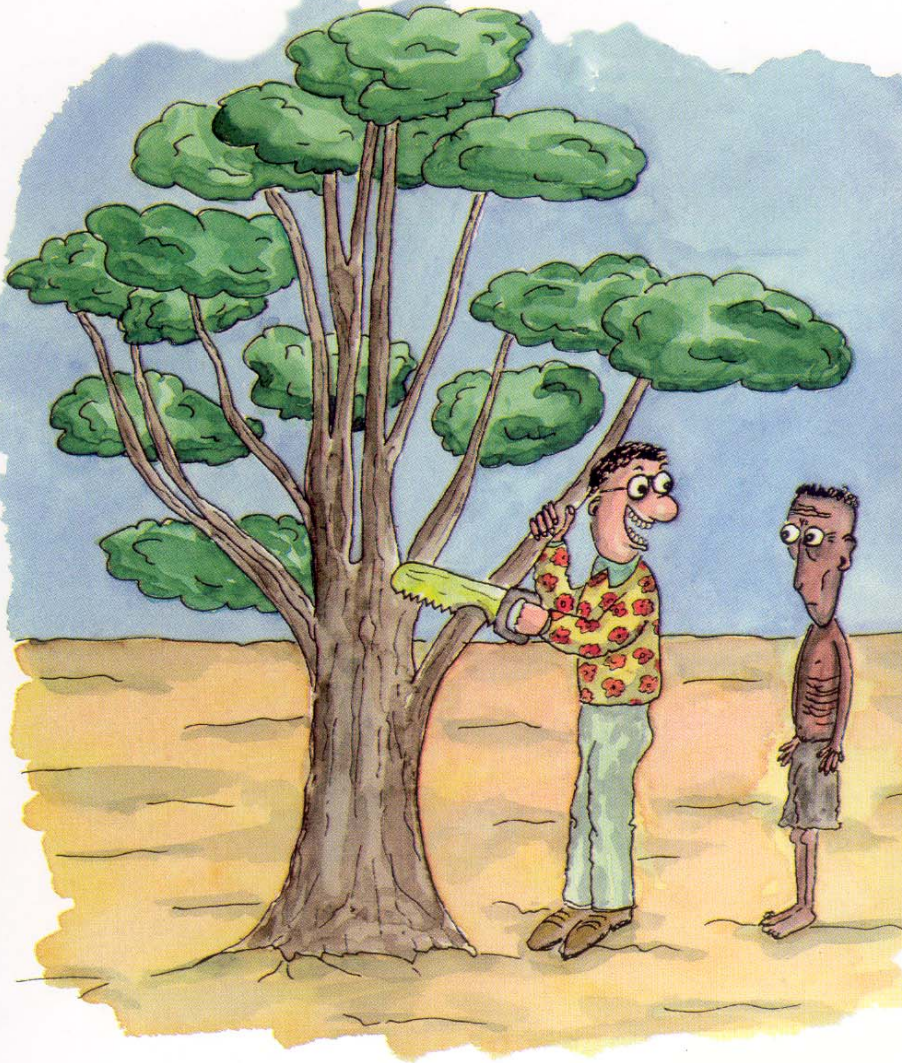
Give him a rod and teach him

don't give him a rod.

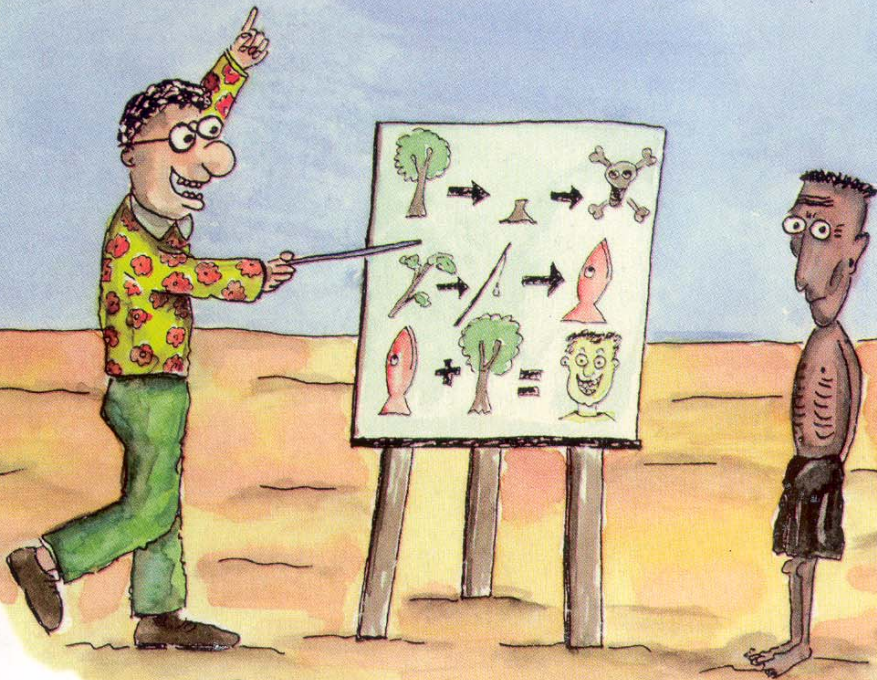


Show him how to make one
in his own environment.



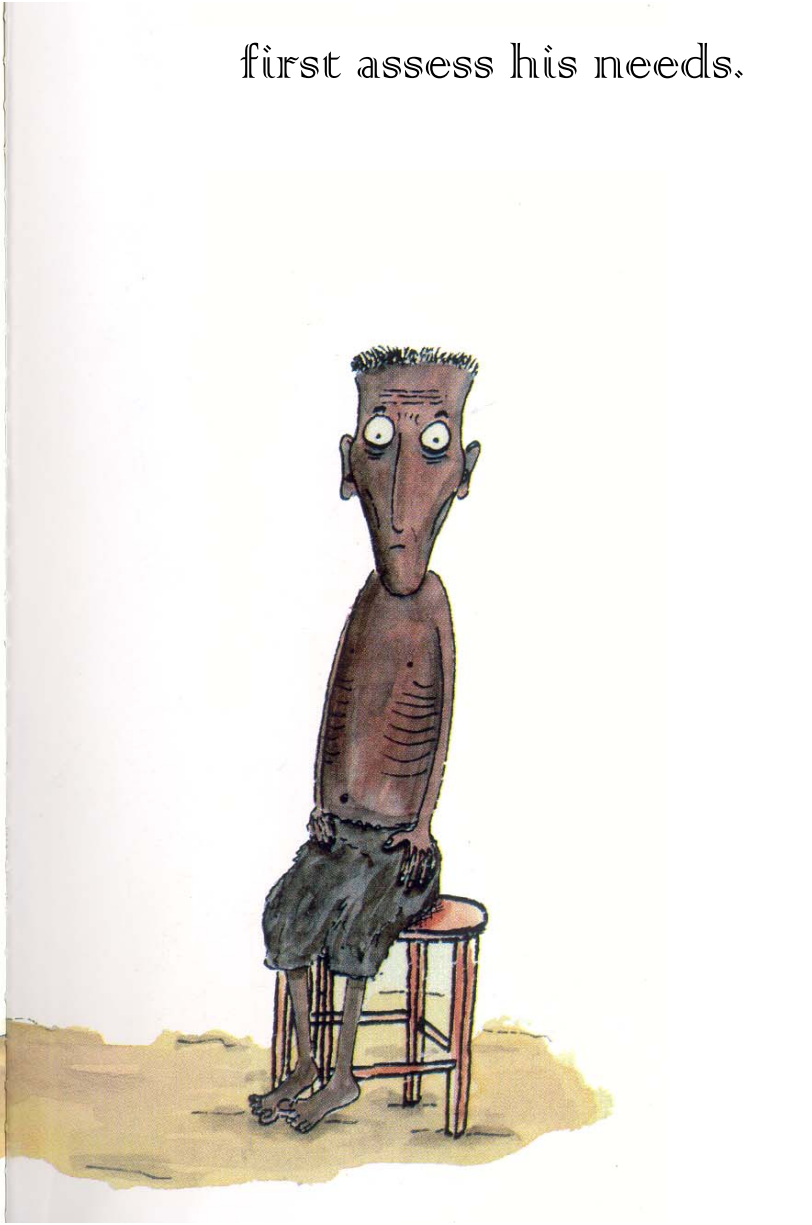
But if a man is hungry

So if a man is hungry,

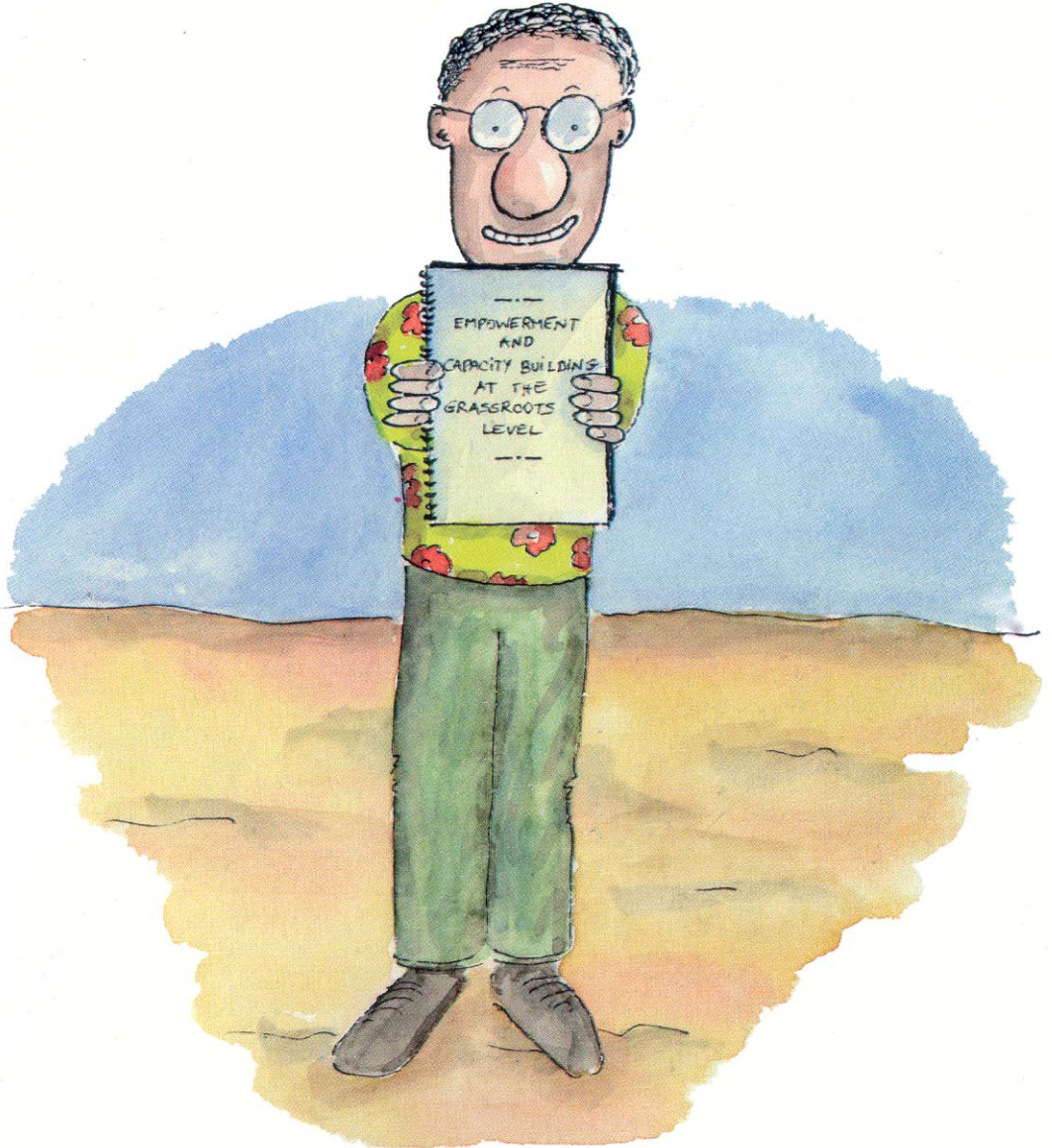
first assess his needs.



Then train some local trainers;



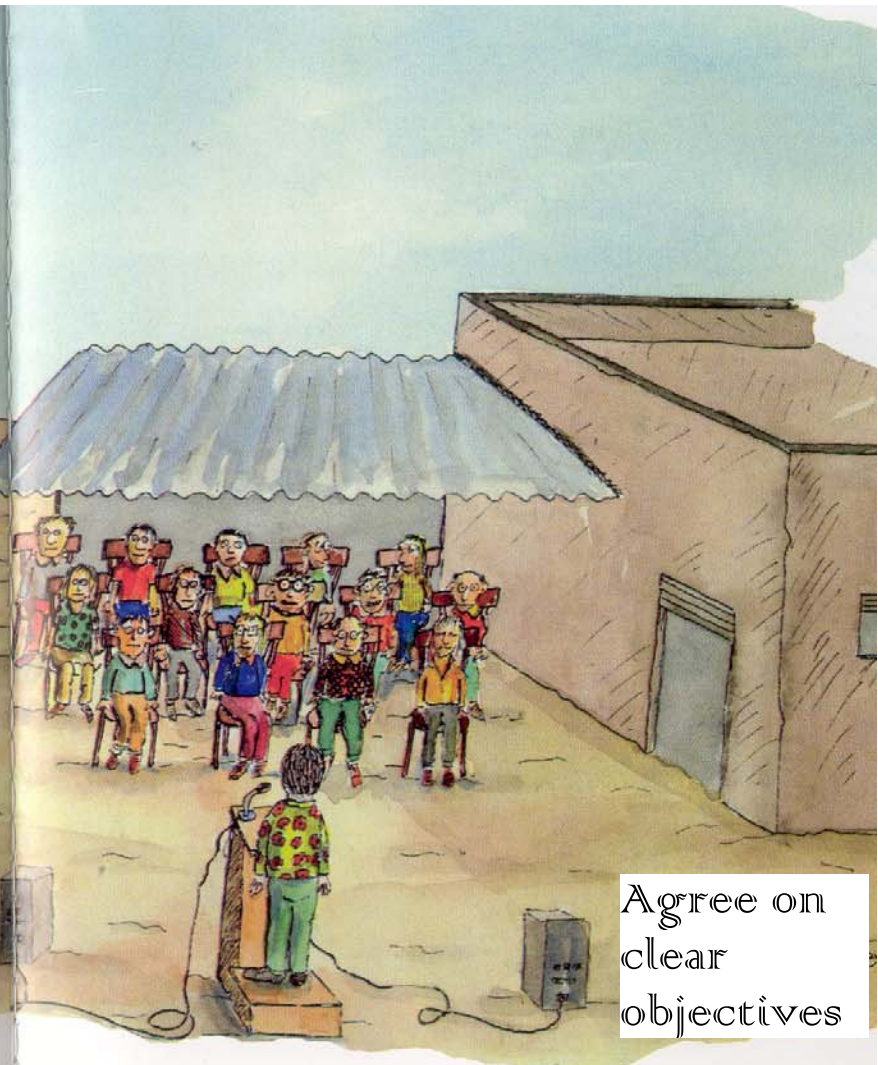
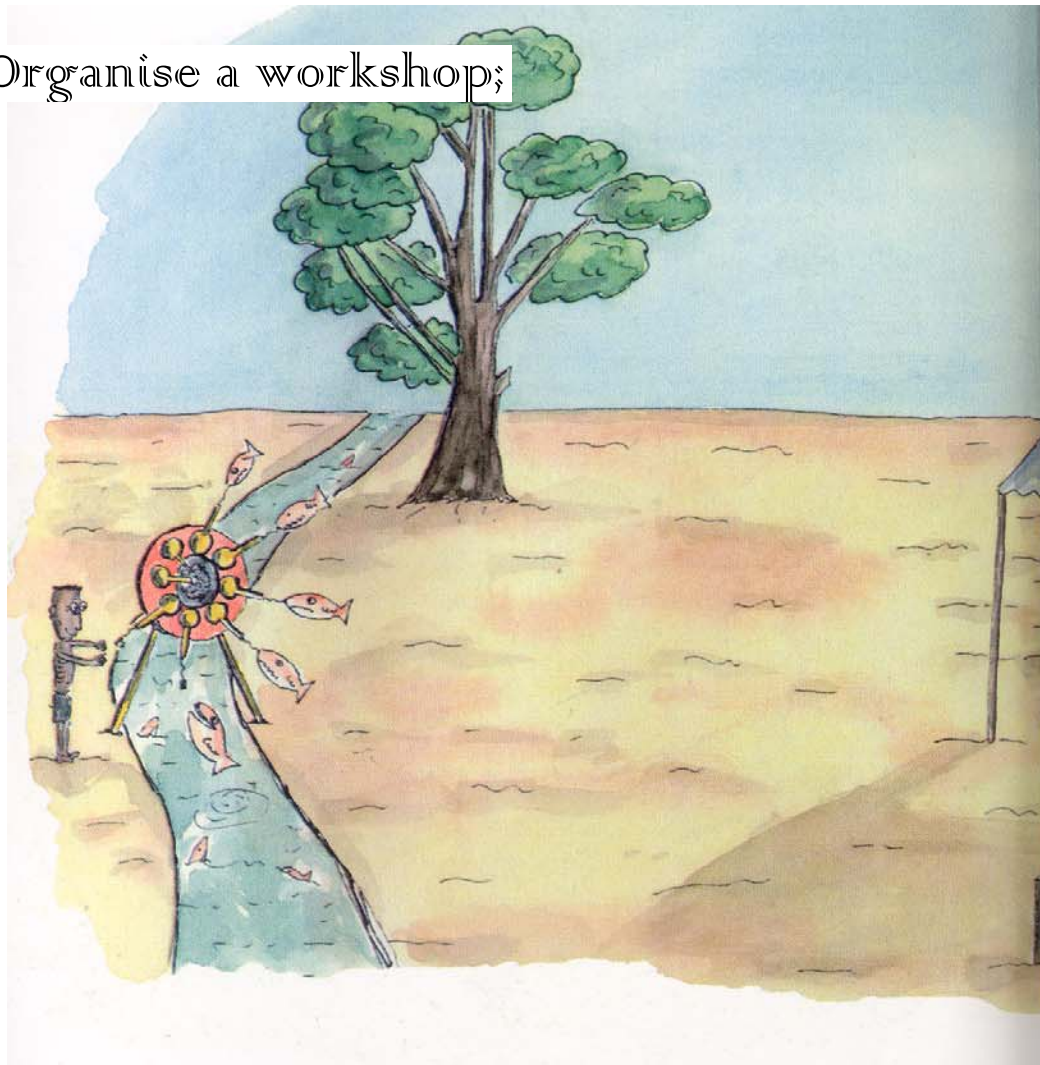
